Viking's Timeline

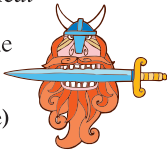


793 First invasion by the Vikings. They raided monasteries on the coast including Lindisfarne, off the coast of Northumbria.

821 Wessex becomes the Supreme Kingdom

865 Great Viking Army from Denmark Invades England

871 King Ethelred, the West Saxon king, and his brother Alfred, defeat the Viking army at the Battle of Ashdown (Berkshire)



886 King Alfred the Great defeats the Vikings but allows them to settle in Eastern England

913 Edward the Elder recaptures Essex from the Danes

926 Athelstan annexes Northumbria, and forces the kings of Wales, Strathclyde, the Picts, and the Scots to submit to him



950 Vikings from Ireland, the Isle of Man and the Hebrides raid Wales, particularly the coastal monasteries

954 Eric Bloodaxe, the last Viking King of Jorvik, is thrown out of York

1001 Vikings land in America and establish a settlement



1014 King Canute (Cnut) of Denmark becomes King of England

1042 Edward the Confessor becomes King (A Saxon King)

1100 End of the Viking age

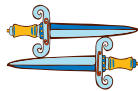


794 First raids on Scotland and Ireland.



820 Viking raids continue around the English coast

866 Danes capture York (which the Vikings called Jorvik) and make it their kingdom (land ruled by a king)



876 Vikings from Denmark, Norway and Sweden settle permanently in England.

901 Edward the Elder takes the title "King of the Angles and Saxons"

924 Athelstan, son of Edward the Elder, becomes King of Wessex and effective ruler of most of England (to 939)



937 Battle of Brunanburh: Athelstan defeats alliance of Scots, Celts, Danes, and Vikings, and takes the title of "King of all Britain"

994 Olaf of Norway and Sven 'Forkbeard', son of the Danish king, lead an invading Danish army in an unsuccessful siege of London, and subsequently ravage southeast England.

980 New Viking Raids on England



1066 Battle of Hastings occurred; William I crowned King of England
