





INCREDIBLE CREATURES

When ten-year-old Arthur shrinks down to a miniscule size he finds himself in a mysterious land as an Invisible. As he explores the Seven Kingdoms he encounters many unusual and intriguing characters.

WHOLE CLASS ACTIVITIES

- Introduce the children to the characters from Arthur and the Invisibles by reading through the Character Information on the Arthur and the Invisibles educational website.
- As you read through each description, ask the children to describe the character's appearance and what else they can deduce about the character's personality from their appearance.
- Discuss what the children think they would look like if they landed in the invisible world and became an Invisible. Ask for volunteers to draw their Invisible self on the board or a sheet of paper.

INDIVIDUAL ACTIVITIES

- Ask the children to imagine that they are an animator for Arthur and the Invisibles. As an animator they need to design a new linvisible character based on themselves, and label all the features that makes their appearance unique. Provide the children with a copy of the worksheet 'Incredible Creatures' for designing their character. The children could draw more than one image of their character to show them from a range of angles.
- In pairs, the children could complete the interactive activity, Arthur's Interactive Fact or Fiction Quiz, that tests the children's knowledge of the characters from Arthur and the Invisibles.
- The children who don't have access to a computer can complete 'Arthur's Fact or Fiction' worksheet. This could also be sent home for the children to complete with their families.
